The Commissioning Discourse (9:35; 10:7)

The Parable Discourse (13:11, 24, 31, 33, 44, 45, 47, 52),

The Community Discourse (18:1, 3, 4, 23), and

The Eschatological Discourse (24:14; 25:1, 34)

Jesus journeys from Nazareth to Capernaum as his Ministry commences.
